The 2007 Fundraiser was a great success. We surpassed the \$25,000 goal, bringing in \$26,505 of cash receipts. Most expenses (\$875) were paid by the MOTT grant; only \$75 came out of funds we raised.

In addition, our fundraising efforts increased awareness about the Society and its programs. As a result, we acquired several new members.

We also found a broad support for our Society within the Phillipston community. Many local businesses gave cash donations; several others gave items for raffle or auction. Also, a substantial number of individuals -- both residents and friends, many not even members of the Society -- enthusiastically volunteered their time to cook, waitress and solicit door-to-door in their neighborhood.
